

ELECTION NOTICE

for the election of representatives in the Senate, the Faculty Councils and the Student Convention of Deggendorf Institute of Technology on 27 June and 28 June 2023

In accordance with Art. 48 of the Bavarian Higher Education Innovation Act (BayHIG), the representatives in the Senate and in the Faculty Councils, and the other representatives in the Student Convention shall be newly elected by the members of the group to which they belong.

Pursuant to the University Constitution of Deggendorf Institute of Technology, these committees include, without prejudice to Art. 50 Para. 1 BayHIG, the following group representatives to be elected:

The representatives in the individual collegial bodies shall be elected in ballots separated according to the individual collegial bodies and groups. The terms of office of the representatives in the Senate, the Faculty Councils and the Student Convention shall commence on 01 October 2023. The terms of office of the student representatives end on 30 September 2024, while those of the other groups end on 30 September 2025.

Voting rights are subject to registration in the electoral roll. The electoral roll can be viewed in the following rooms

from **23 May to 25 May 2023 between 8am to 4pm**. Objections against non-registration or incorrect registration in the electoral roll may be filed in writing with the returning officer by **26 May 2023, 4pm**, at the latest.

People entitled to vote are requested to submit **nominations** separately according to their committees to the returning officer in the period from

25 April to 08 May 2023.

Nominations must be made in writing. Sample nominations forms are available at the **faculty secretary's office and on the university website**.

Nominations for the election of representatives in the Senate and for the student representatives in the Student Convention must be **personally signed** by at least ten supporters, nominations for the election of representatives in the faculty

councils must be **personally signed** by at least five supporters entitled to vote for the respective body.

On signing the nomination, the nominators must state the faculty to which they belong along with their surname and given name. A person entitled to vote may support only **one nomination** for an election to a collegiate body; if a person has signed more than one nomination, the signature on all the nominations shall be invalid. Nominations that are submitted late are invalid. Only candidates who are included in a valid nomination can be elected.

The number of candidates in a nomination may not exceed three times the number of representatives to be elected. In the election of student representatives to the faculty councils, the number shall be increased to twice the maximum number of student representatives belonging to the respective faculty student council, i.e. to 16.

The names of the individual candidates shall be listed one below the other on the nominations form and shall be numbered consecutively. In addition to the surname, given name and faculty must be indicated. A **written declaration of consent** of the candidate to stand for election must be submitted along with the nominations form. A candidate may only be listed on one nomination for election to a collegial body.

Voting will take place on

27 June and 28 June from 9am to 2pm.

The **voting location** will be communicated in an election notification. Those entitled to vote shall receive the election notifications by e-mail before the electoral roll is closed.

Voting by postal vote is also permitted. Any person entitled to vote intending to cast their vote in the form of a postal vote must apply to the returning officer for the voting documents to be sent or handed out, using the form provided with the notification of the election bearing their **own personal** signature. The application must be received by the returning officer no later than **4pm on 13 June 2023**. If the postal voting documents are collected in person, applications for postal

voting may be submitted until **4pm on 20 June 2023** at ITC 2, room 2.46b, Dieter-Görlitz-Platz 1, 94469 Deggendorf.
